Motionhouse Training for Teachers

An important part of our role as a professional dance company is helping dance teachers train and inspire the next generation. We know that many teachers don't feel confident delivering dance (especially at Primary school level) and so, we're here to help.

We regularly work with education professionals of all levels to develop their skills, knowledge and confidence in teaching dance. Tailored training for teachers in sessions ranging from twilights (1-2 hours after-school), half or full day (INSET) or longer intensive trainings; we can a range of topics all designed with you in mind. Our signature style is dance-circus and much of this includes gymnastic, athletic dance movements; ticking off many outcomes of the P.E curriculum such as the development of:
